
PANTS:

SLACKS: dark only: navy blue, black

NO jeans, pants with oversized pockets or cargo pants (with pockets running down the length of the pants-only pockets on the top-sides) No pants which are intentionally styled with a rip at the knees. No elastic cuff pants.

SHIRTS:

SHIRTS: collar, button down: solid white, solid blue, solid light blue NO stripes or lines whatsoever.



Haircuts should be in line with what is acceptable for a student of Cheder Menachem. The same number cut should be used for the haircut all around. Parents will be called to pick up their son should he come to school with a haircut not aligned with the Cheder dress code.

SWEATSHIRTS:

SHOES:

SHOES: BLACK SNEAKERS ONLY: There is enough of a selection of black sneakers available for older boys online and in stores of decent quality and affordable pricing. Please purchase sneakers in accordane with the dress code. Note: Sneaker laces must be black as well. NO high tops, light ups, roller skate sneakers or CROCS. If your child needs to wear crocs for medical reasons, you must provide a note from a medical doctor and only then can black crocs be worn.
