#6 שבת קדש ג' שבט

In honor of Yud Shevat, which this year is the 60th Anniversary of the Rebbe saying the first Maamar, Basi Legani, we are presenting a special opportunity for our Talmidim and their families to learn this Maamar.

In this Maamar, the Rebbe lays the foundation for our generation, who we are, what our job is, and how we can accomplish this.

As the concepts in the Maamar range from simple to deep, we will be presenting a summary of each סעיף with the main points explained.

From now until Yud Shevat, we will be IYH sending home one part every day. Ideally, this should be learned as a family, together, at supper time (or another appropriate time).

Ideally, each day's portion should not be merely read by rote, but should lead to lively discussion involving all the members of the family as to its understanding and application! (Of course, this program is a supplement to learning the ma'amar with age-appropriate iyun that will be taking place in class.)

אות ו' Summary of

The Rebbe quotes the Maamor (באתי לגני) of the פריערדיקער רבי, where the פריערדיקער רבי talks about the main דירה (dwelling place) of the שכינה, which was in the בית המקדש. The פריערדיקער רבי talks about the fact that the משכן was made out of עצי שטים (wood from שטים) (especially), because that shows us that our עבודה (job), is to change the זזה (silliness) of Kelipa – opposite of קדושה (silliness) of קדושה – meaning, a level of קדושה which is higher than we can understand).

The Rebbe says that everything the Rebbeim ask of us, they do themselves, and they **show** us that they do it, in order to make it easier for us to do.

The Rebbe continues with stories that show the אהבת ישראל of the Rebbeim – we will learn these in the next two sheets אי"ה.
